The Practice of Animal Law in the UK

It is often stated that as animals are property under law they do not possess legal rights. Whilst I appreciate there may be academic questions surrounding the very definition of a right and the very definition of personhood, from a practitioner's perspective it is hard to see how the legislation I spend so much of my life advising on is not granting certain rights and channels of redress for animals.
